

Kayne Eras COVID-19 Safety Plan

In response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the Kayne Eras School has developed a COVID-19 Safety Plan to be used in conjunction with the ECF COVID-19 Prevention Plan.

This Safety Plan relies on common understanding of a “multiple barrier approach” to reduce exposure and transmission of the COVID-19 virus. Students and staff will be safer, and our school will be stronger when multiple barriers separate them from the virus.

Barriers include:

- Personal health and hygiene – stay home if you are sick, avoid touching your face, etc.
- Hand Washing – Effective and frequent
- Face Coverings – Follow CDC, state and local guidelines
- Physical Distancing – Maintain 6 feet distance
- Cleaning Procedures - Common areas/points of contact multiple times daily and as necessary
- Personal Protective Equipment – As required and necessary for the setting
- Training Requirements - See ECF COVID-19 Prevention Plan

The purpose of this COVID-19 Safety Plan is to identify and communicate the Kayne Eras School’s plan for protecting the health of all employees, students and visitors to our school building. This plan is effective immediately in response to guidance and regulations put in place by the state and local authorities.

All administrators, managers and supervisors are required to be familiar with and support the implementation of the Safety Plan in the school building.

Application:

All parts of this COVID19 Safety Plan apply to all operations of the Kayne Eras School and should be considered prior to entering the building or planning activities/events. In order to maintain the safety and well-being of all staff, students and visitors, it is important to review these expectations/procedures and the ECF COVID-19 Prevention Program before participating in any in-person school involvement.
